

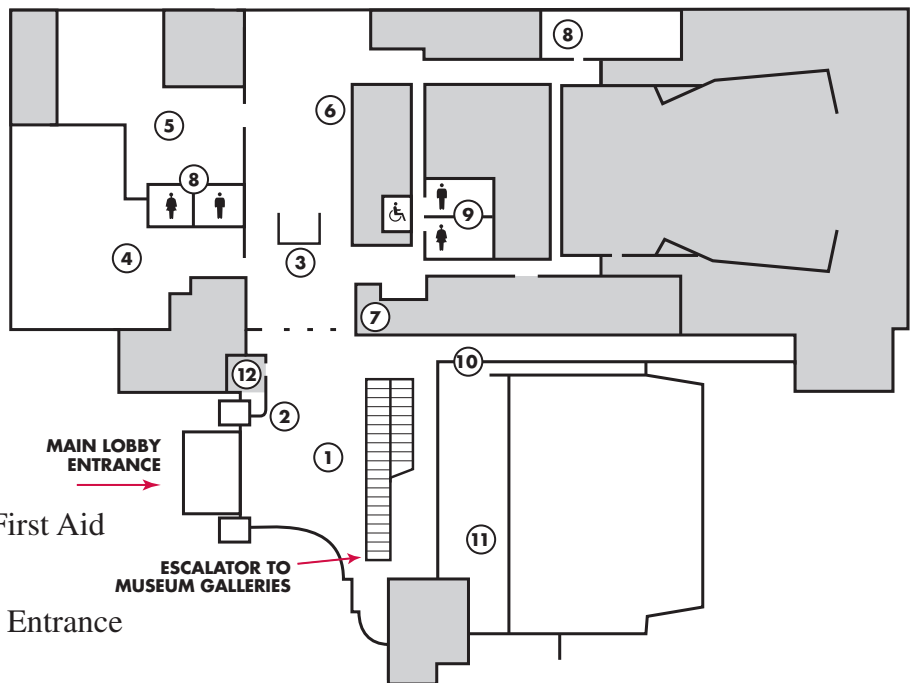
# Royal British Columbia Museum

Show your museum ticket at the coat check (6); leave your bags and coat and head to the escalator or elevator (12) to enter the galleries.

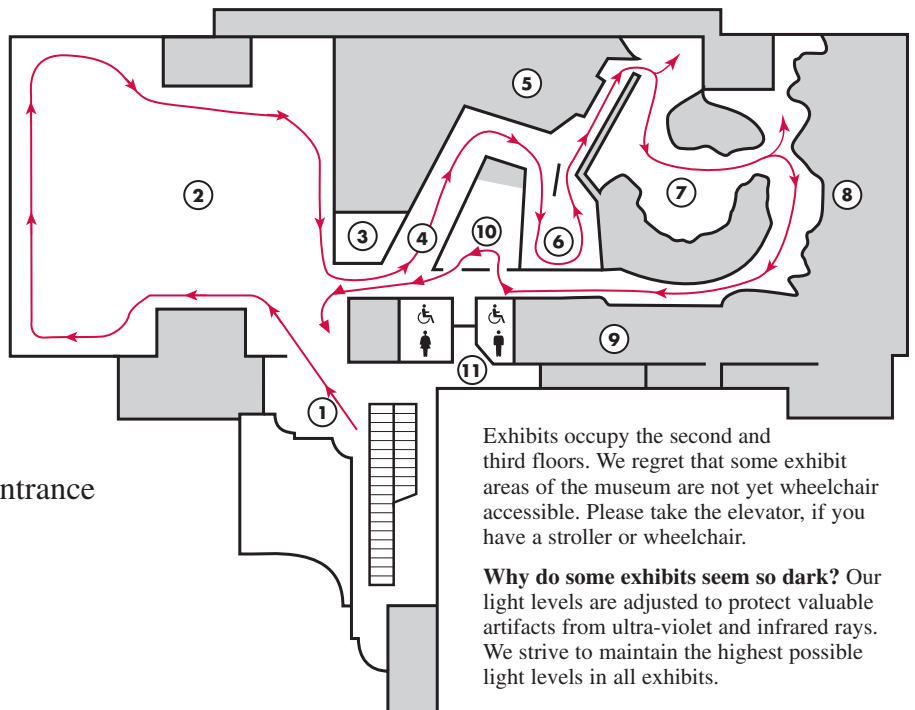

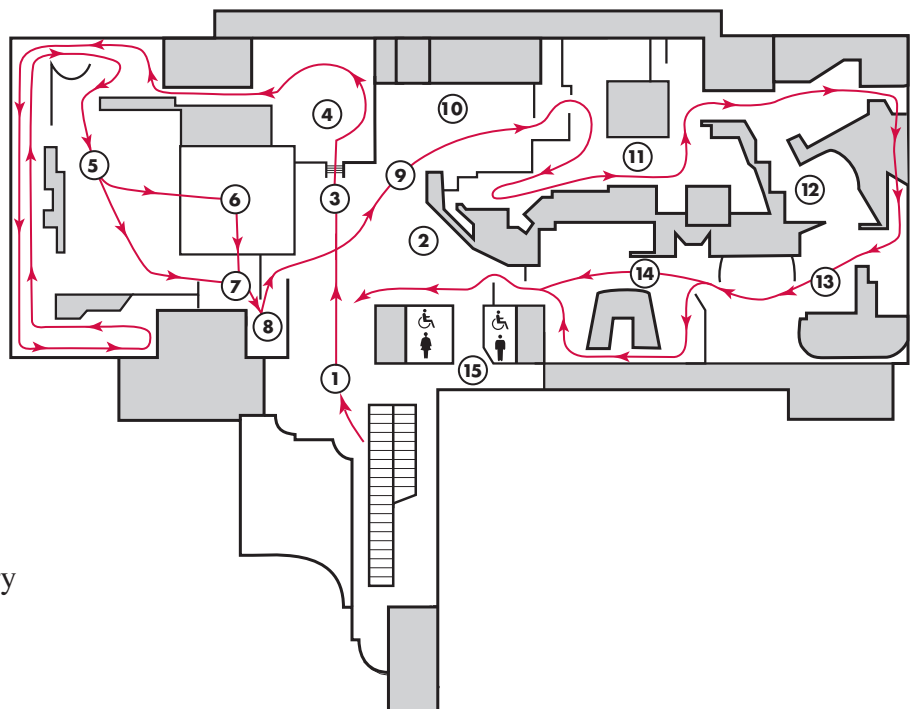
